Ahuā	gathered paiai for shipment to Kalaupapa	Pāwaa (old school site)
Kukuiini	Laheloa's father-in-law's 2 story house	
Mokulehua	Nākì taro loi ('ai uiae)	
Kōpēna	Wusty "road" merges w/ present trail	
Lauhoukeea	wide gravel trail	
Pōhabuhina		
Ululohlo	last loi to ^{be} cultivated (spring)	
Palēloa	first paiai perennial stream - oriental bamboo	
Keanakou	mango trees + "Big Pond"	
Mānnakōpe	'Ohe Heuuhi - Stream on Mauna Boundary route to Māni Falls "ili"	
Paihala	Trail extends across valley	
Mālame	cultivation from here to sea in 1910 (John Kāne)	
Po'okinkaha	Mark morita stone	
Maiāloa	ends in 'ape	
Pōhakukahakaka	start w/ conglomerate in stream - breccia	
Waīhā	start w/ "Big O'opu pool"	- Waimana Stream junction
Oloñā	pōhakue "lauhā"	- dike in Stream bed crossing
Kopuriiki	spring spring - camping area - cross Waiake ahu Stream	
Kekama	ends with start of ridge trail	
Po'oke'olii	point where ridge levels for a bit	
Hauineawai	forney ghen where ridge starts to climb again
